- 1. Deadline for scholarship application is <u>4:00pm, April 5, 2022</u>. Late applications will not be accepted.
- 2. Refer to criteria below for eligibility requirements. Refer to application process below for a list of the supporting documents needed (i.e., reference forms, evidence of GPA, etc.).
- 3. Type or print legibly.
- 4. Applicant(s) will be awarded the Pure Truth scholarship and will be notified by June 1.

Purpose: The Pure Truth program of Grace House Ministries serves to enable students to reach their greatest potential academically, emotionally, in character and in healthy relationships. The Pure Truth scholarship seeks to award one or more students, who have adopted these potentials for his or herself and positively influences their peers to make the same decision.

Award Components: A sum between \$500 and \$1000 for the awarded recipient, sent directly to the institution of the recipients' choice.

Award Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a senior level student as defined through credit hours at their institution.
- 2. Applicant must attend a Parker County high school or, as a homeschool student, live in Parker County.
- 3. Applicant must have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Applicant must show their leadership of character, be it in the classroom or out, and desire to carry out a lifestyle of positive influence, for their peers.


Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- 1. Completed application form, on back (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- 2. Five (5) character references in the form of a letter of recommendation. References should be adult leaders and not family-related. Examples would be teachers, principal, church youth minister, church pastor, etc. References should be given the attached Letter of Recommendation Form and return electronically to Sandra Campbell, Pure Truth Coordinator sandra@thepuretruth.net or mailed to Pure Truth Scholarship Program, c/o Grace House Ministries, 919 E. - 3. A copy of their most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- 4. Personal Essay. In the essay, the following question should be answered, either typed or legibly handwritten. How have you been a positive influence on your peers or community? [600 words or less]
- 5. Applicant must agree to a personal interview with the selection committee, if requested. Interviews will be conducted in April.
